From North (Indianapolis)

Take Interstate 465 south to Interstate 65 south. Follow I-65 south to exit #99 (Greenwood). Turn right (west) when you come off of the interstate. Drive west on Main Street through 2 stoplights and Valle Vista is on the left.

From South (Columbus IN/Louisville)

Take Interstate 65 North to exit #99 (Greenwood). Turn left (west) when exiting and drive west through 3 stop lights and Valle Vista will be on the left.

From West (Martinsville/Bloomington)

Take State Road 37 north to Smith Valley Road. Turn right and travel east on Smith Valley Road through Greenwood. Continue on Smith Valley as it becomes Emerson Ave. Turn left from Emerson onto Main Street. Valle Vista will be on the left (south) side of the road.
